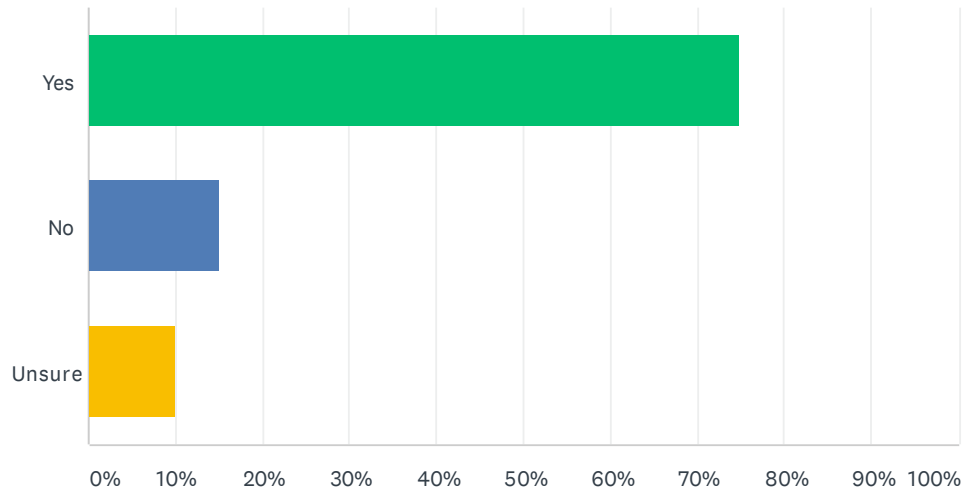


## Q1 Have you been exposed to COVID-19?

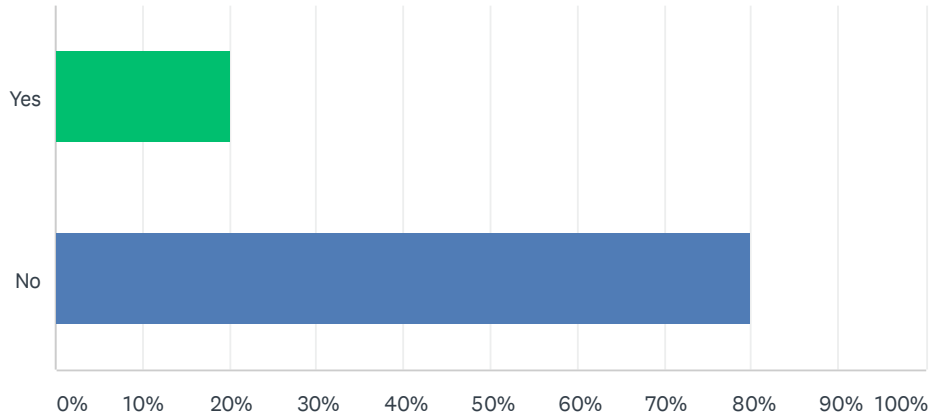

## Q2 Have you tested positive for COVID-19?

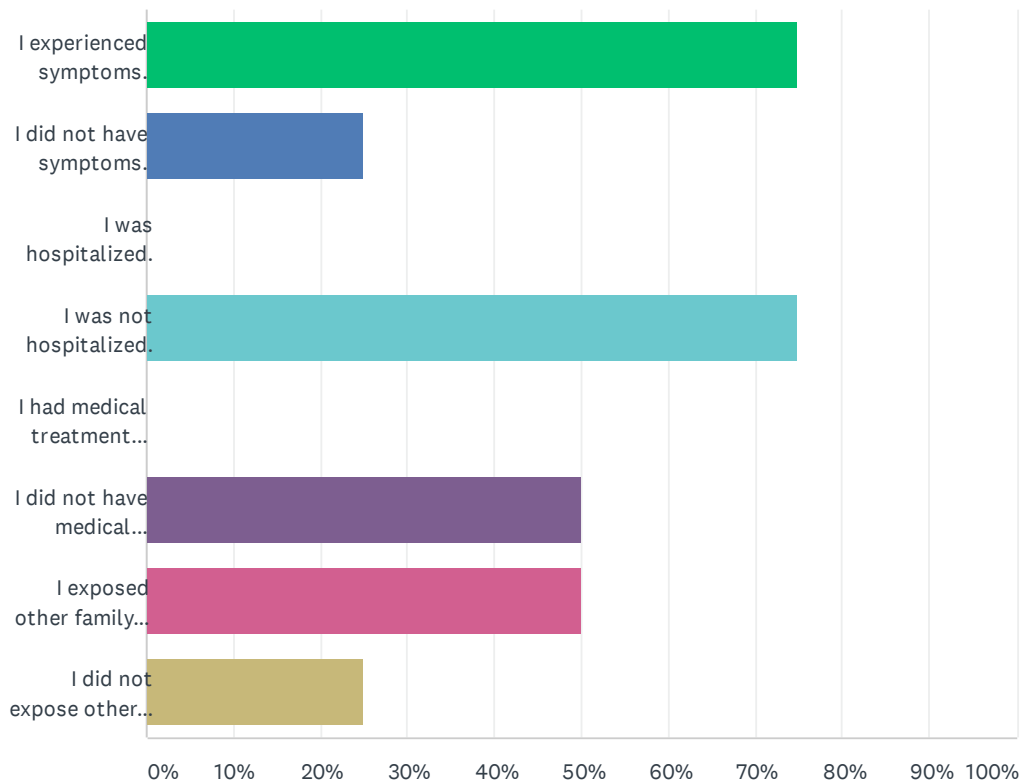

### Q3 Please mark all that applied to you when testing positive for COVID-19.

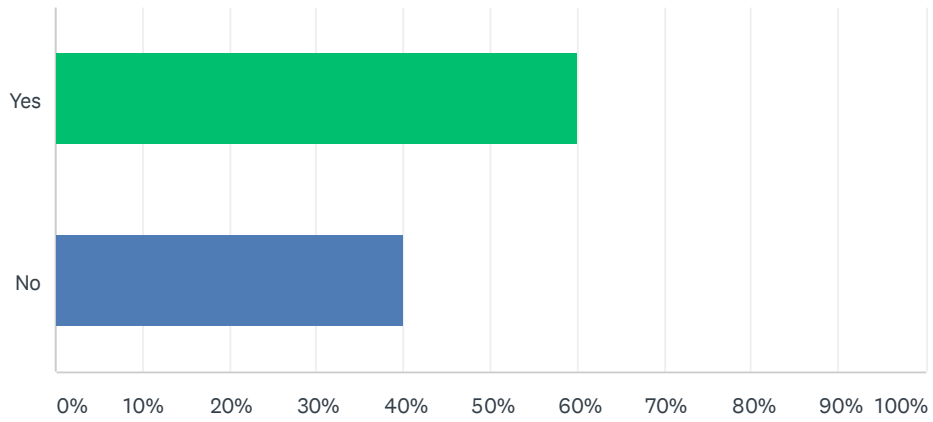

### Q4 If you have had to quarantine or isolate, did you receive paid leave?

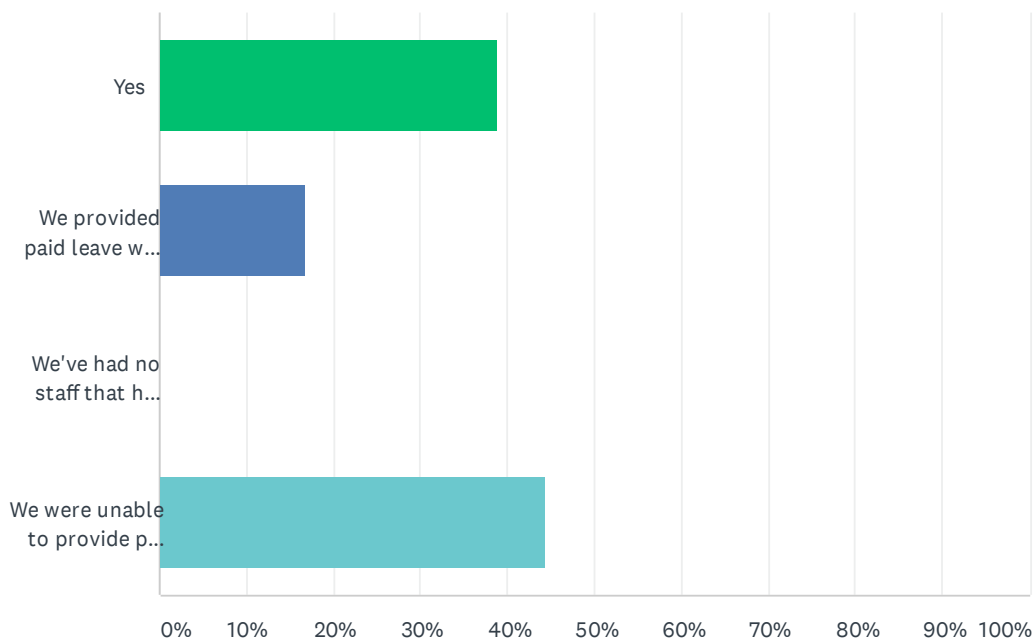

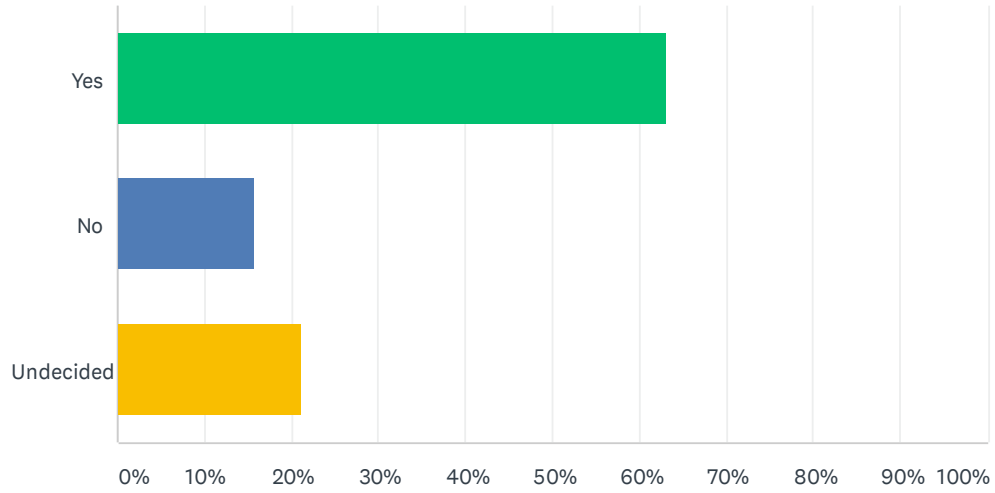

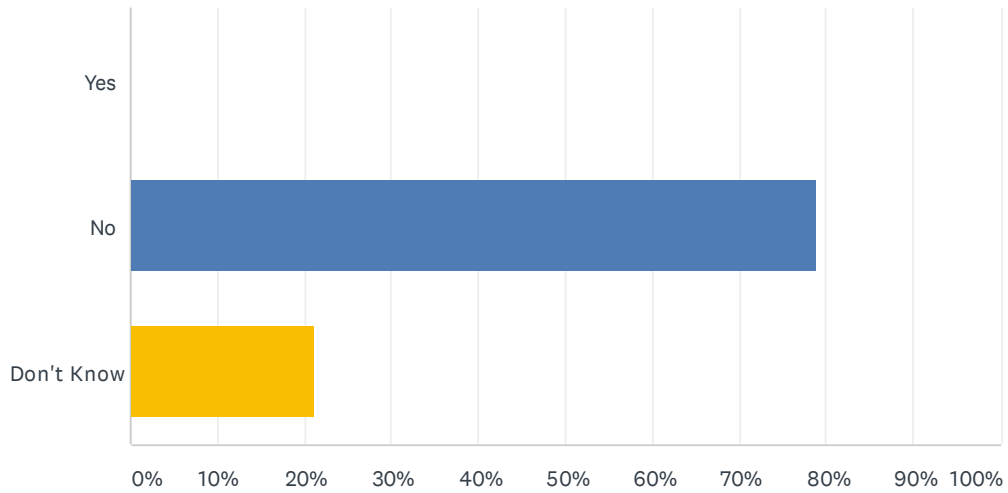

## Q9 Will you be required to take the vaccine by your employer?

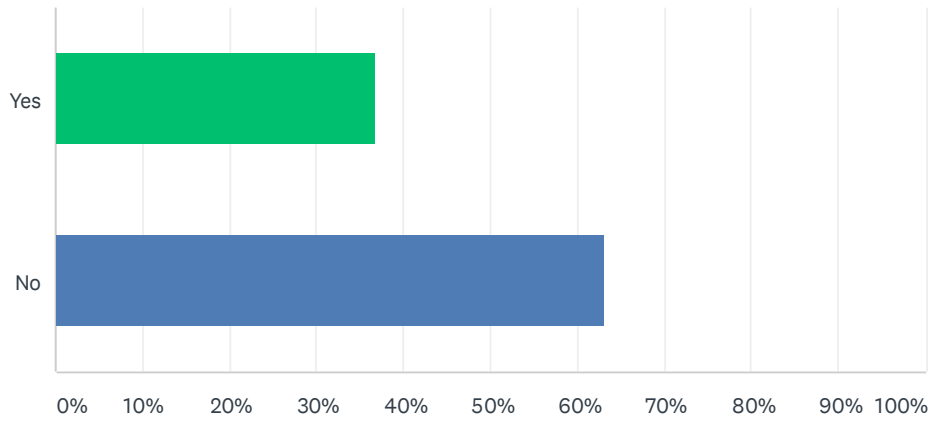

## Q10 Are you currently working short-staffed?

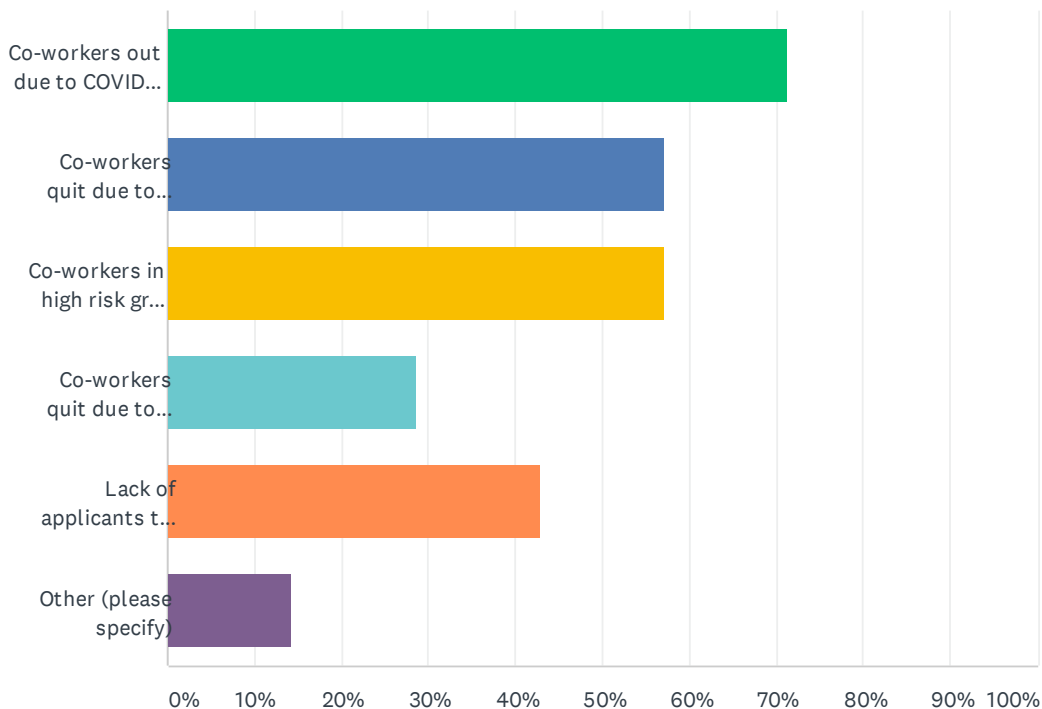

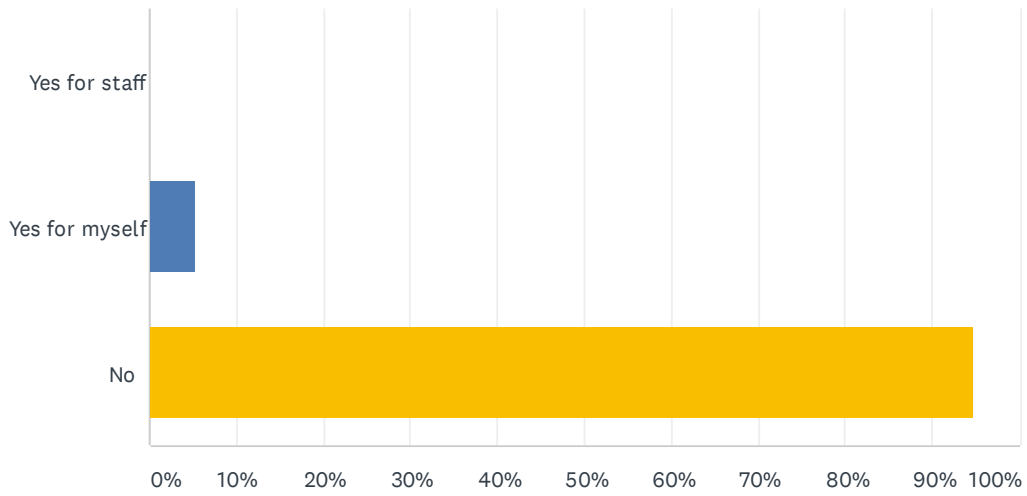

## Q12 Have you accessed any of the state's free mental health services available to you?

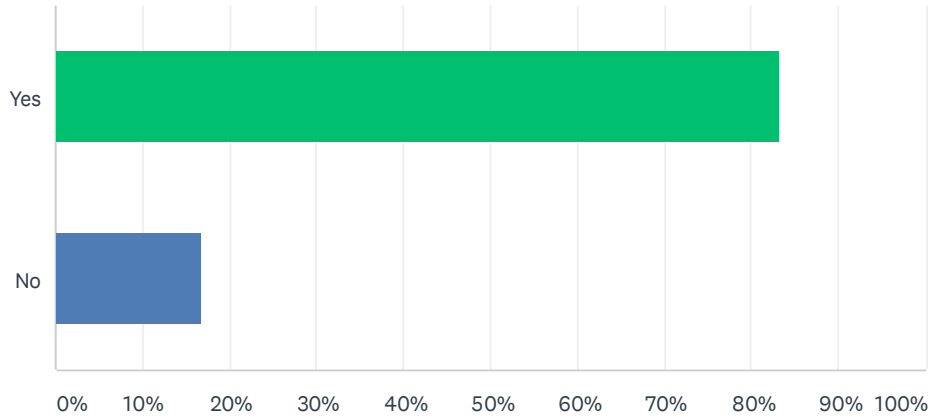

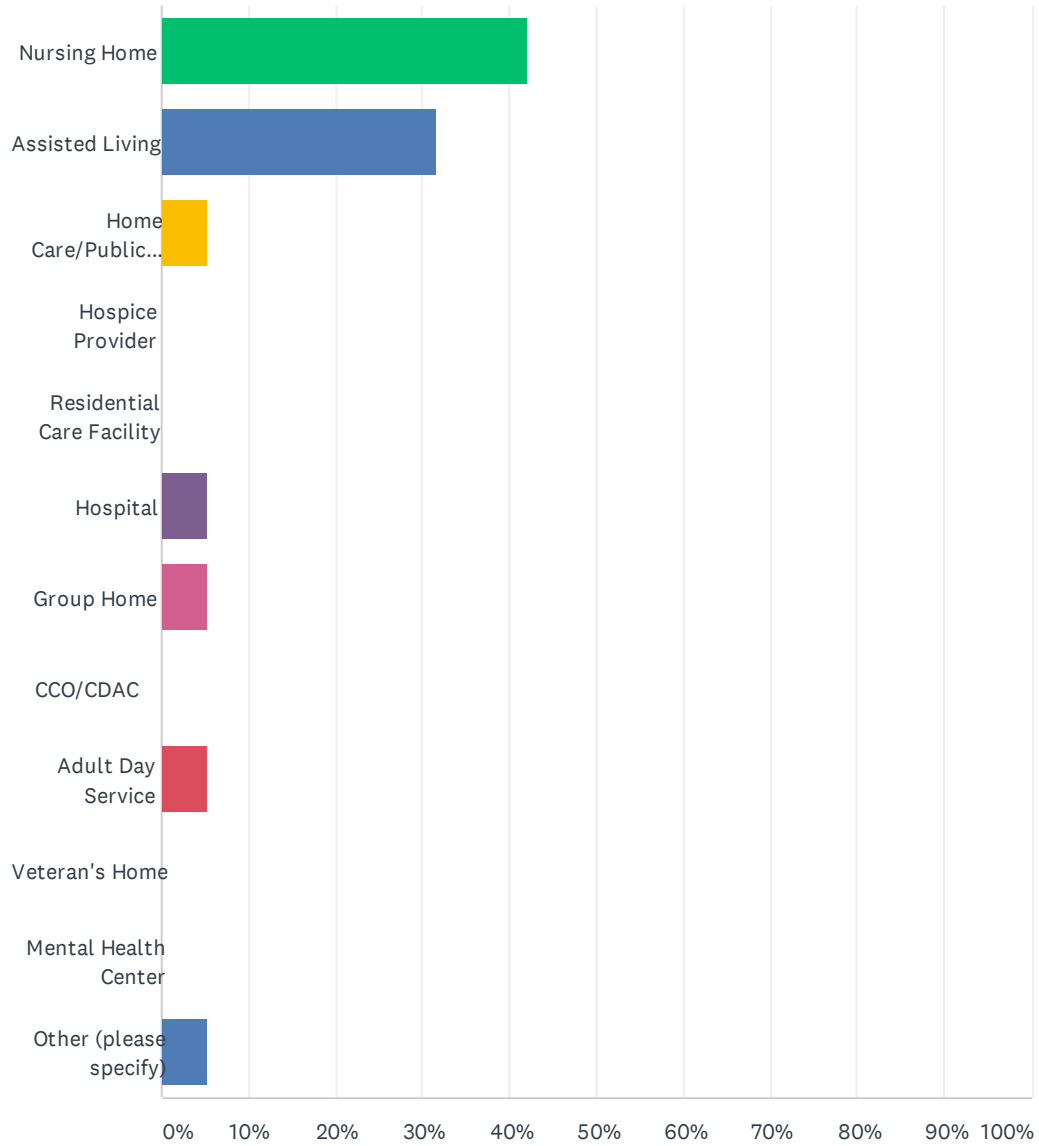

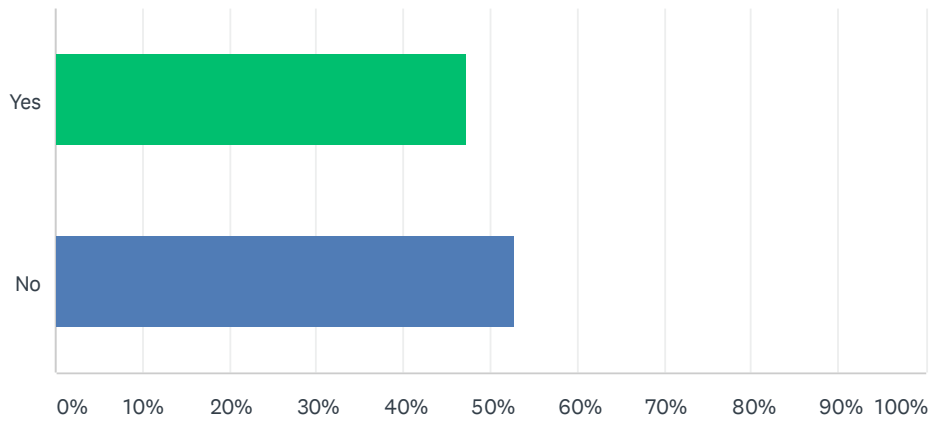
