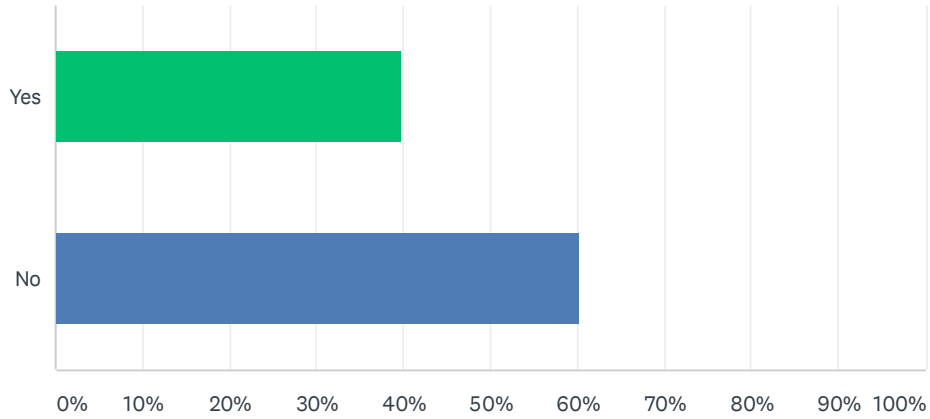


# Q1 Are you a health care worker facing additional child care challenges due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19)?

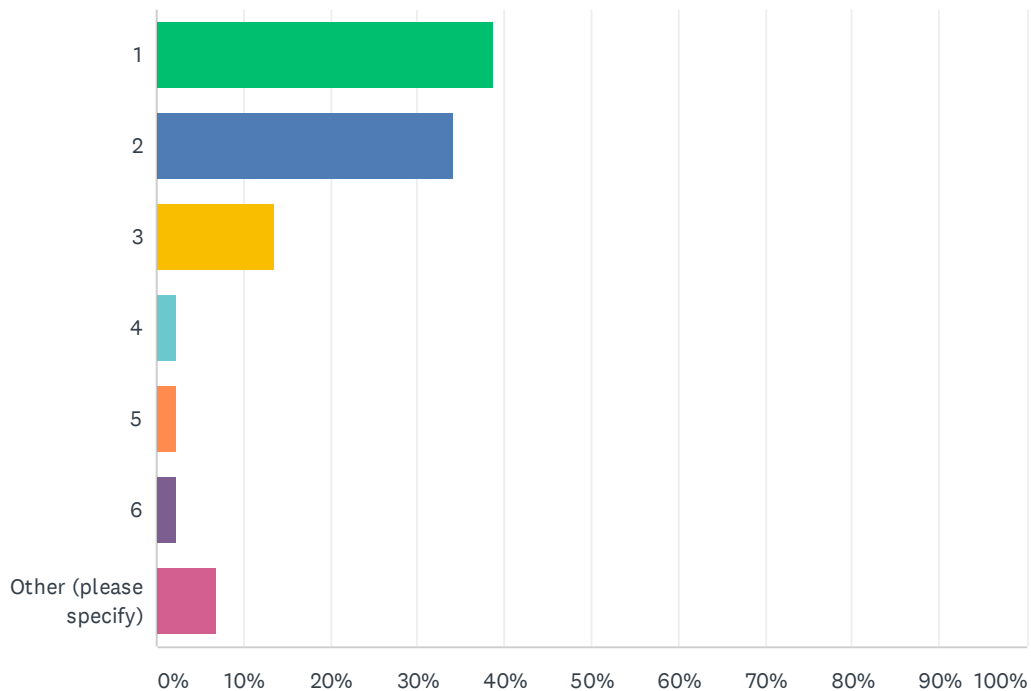

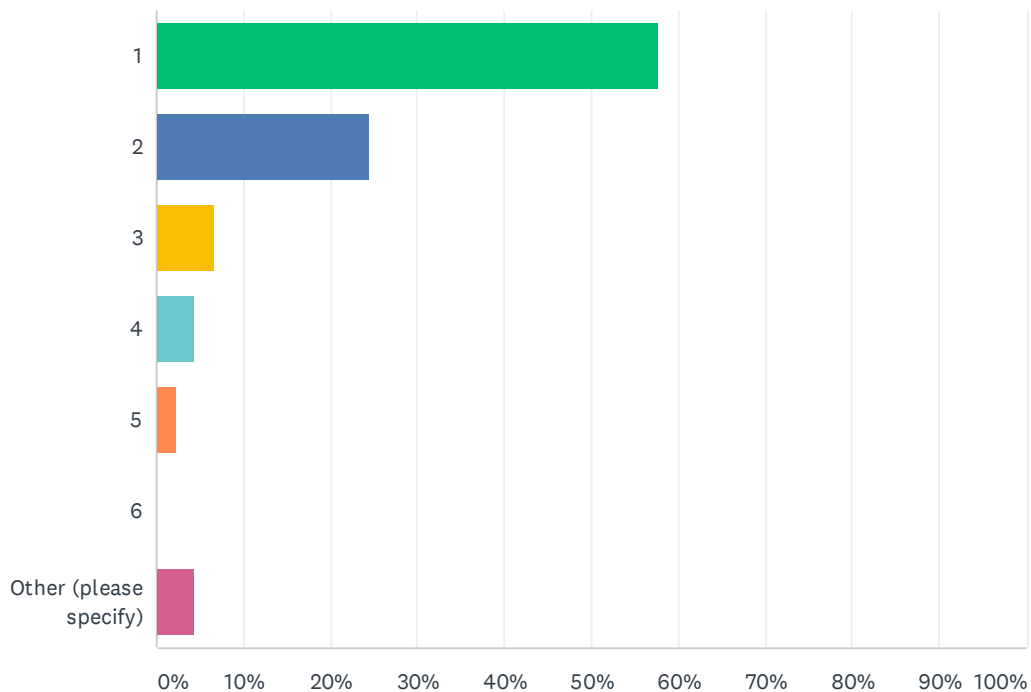

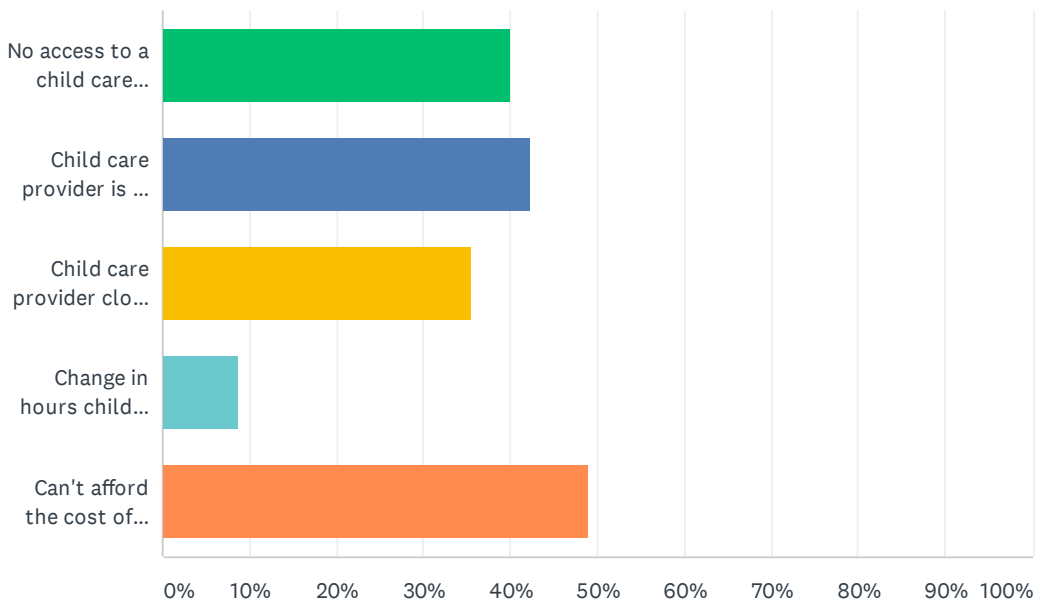

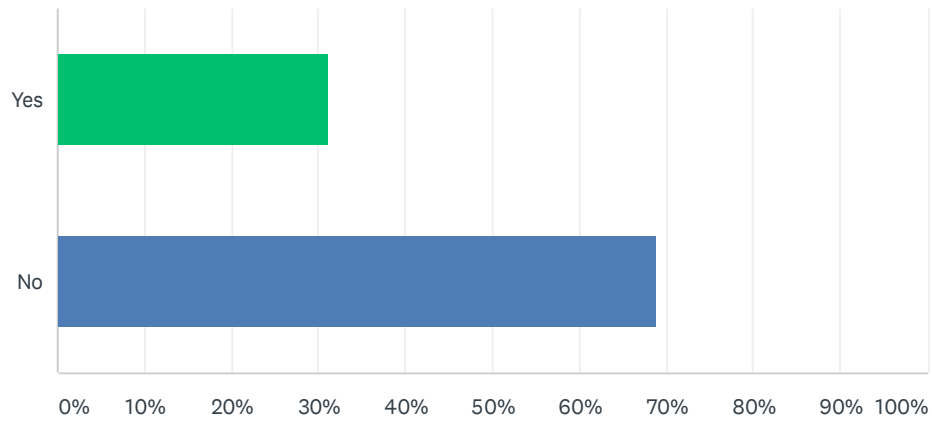

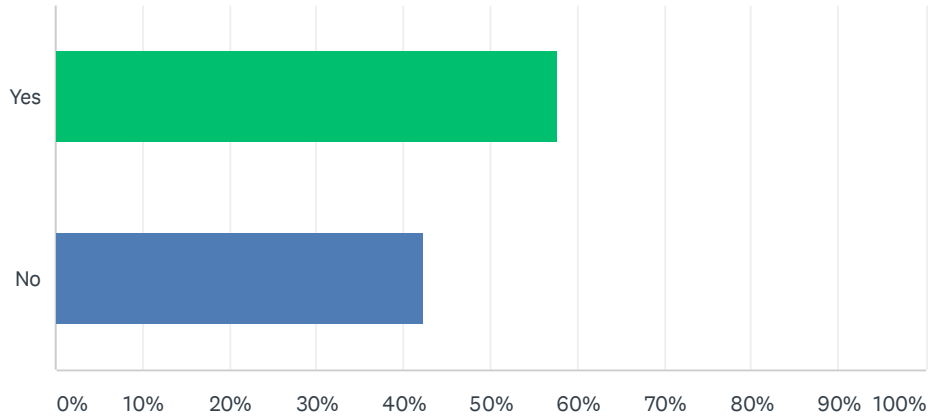

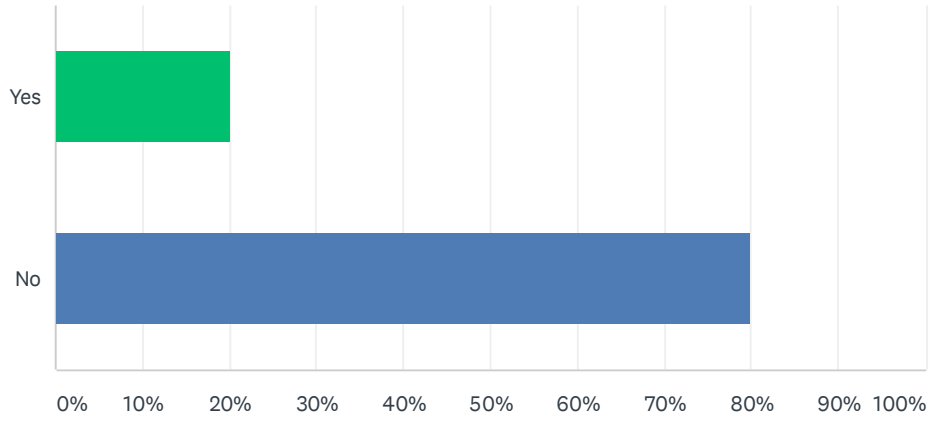
