Reardon Honored For 43 Years in Direct Care!

Deb Reardon, a Home Health Aide at Clayton County Visiting Nurse Association (VNA) in Elkader, Iowa was recently honored by Iowa CareGivers for her 43 years in the field of direct care. The recognition took place on October 10, 2022, during Iowa CareGivers "Winners at Caregiving" conference, held at the FFA Enrichment Center, on the DMACC campus, in Ankeny, IA. Reardon's 43-year career has been spent providing care in nursing homes and for the past 25 years, in home care and she is still working.

Reardon received the Margaret Swanson Legacy in Giving Award. "This Swanson Legacy in Giving Award is important, said Maribel Slinde, Chair, Iowa CareGivers Board of Directors, because it counters the belief by some that direct care isn't a profession that anyone would choose as a career. Deb and many like her should not be viewed as entry level workers in entry level jobs. She has devoted 43 years to her profession and has touched the lives of thousands of Iowans."

The award, named in memory of the late Margaret Swanson, long-time lowa CareGivers volunteer board member and supporter, is held in high esteem by the lowa CareGivers. Margaret understood what an important role direct care workers play after witnessing the care they provided her daughter, Chris, who was in a coma and later died following a serious car crash. Margaret was a great advocate for those who work in direct care and in her will directed funds to establish the Margaret Swanson lowa CareGivers Endowment at the Community Foundation of Greater Des Moines.

When asked about her 43 years in the field, Deb said, "when I started out young it was just a way to make some money. I'm not sure exactly when that changed to becoming my passion."
